

GUIDELINES FOR AUTHORS: ORAL PRESENTATIONS

Presentations at the conference will be based on the selected abstract submissions. All individual papers will be grouped thematically in panels, disposed by concurrent sessions of generally 1,5 hours.

All session rooms will be equipped with a laptop computer, data projector and wireless internet access.

Oral presentations should be no longer than 15 minutes, which will be followed by time for questions and discussion from the audience. It is important that presentation time is strictly adhered to, so that fruitful reflexion and debate can take place.

The oral presentations should be concise, providing inspiring analyses and reflections on the concept and practices of “creative tourism”.

Innovative presentation formats are welcome! In this case, and especially if special supports are needed, presenters should notify the CREATOUR team (creatour@ces.uc.pt) ahead of time in order to assess whether the request is possible.

Presenters should:

1- Bring their presentation in a USB flash drive, so it can be loaded on the local laptop. Presenters may also send their presentations in MS Powerpoint or Adobe PDF slides to creatour@ces.uc.pt until May 26th 2017 as a backup.

2- Check the room for their presentation session (information will be made available in due time) and arrive in the session room at least 5 minutes prior to the start of the session to copy it on resident laptop and confirm other presentation details with the Session Chair

3- Language: the primary language of the event will be English, therefore presentations should be made, preferably, in English. Presentations in Portuguese are also welcome, but in this case we advise the authors to have their presentation support (slides) in English. Unfortunately, translation support in sessions will not be possible.

Note: Full papers are not required prior to the conference. Further details on publications arising from the conference will be provided during the event.
